Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) or Food Stamps helps low-income families buy food. While the Welfare program (TANF) assists those who have little or no income.

The County of Powhatan Virginia provides services that are free and confidential. The direct services they provide include the following: Support Groups, Counseling/Education, Case Management, Information and Referral (to the food bank, legal services, enrolling in GED program, getting to medical appointments, filling out applications for Food Stamps, etc.), and Emergency Housing Coordination/Transportation. They also facilitate a Women's Support Group, where they provide safety, options, and support for individuals who have experienced or are currently experiencing intimate partner violence. Group is free and confidential, and childcare is provided.
