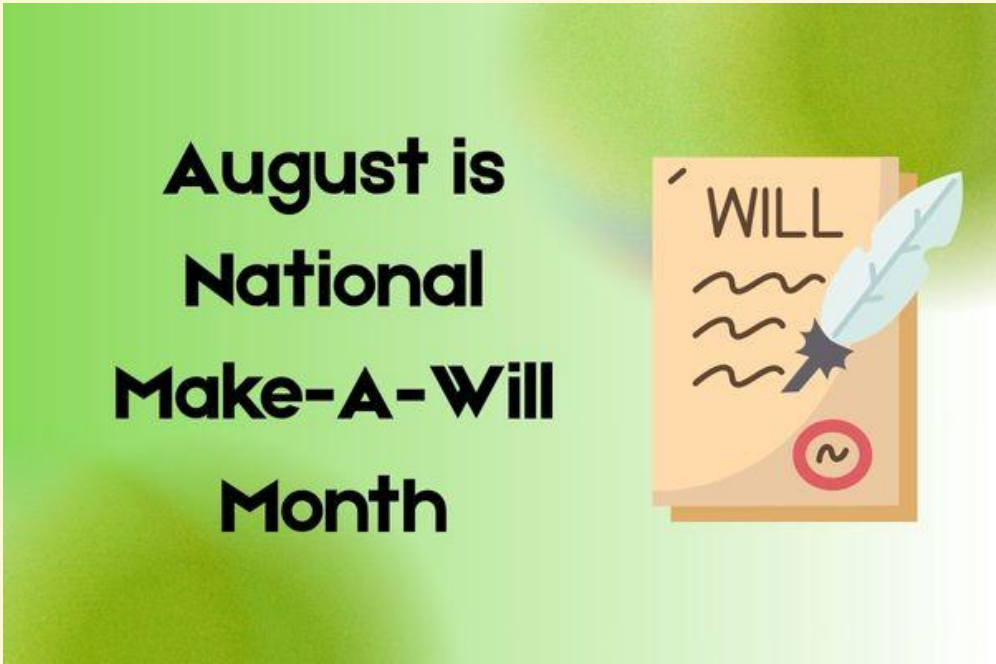
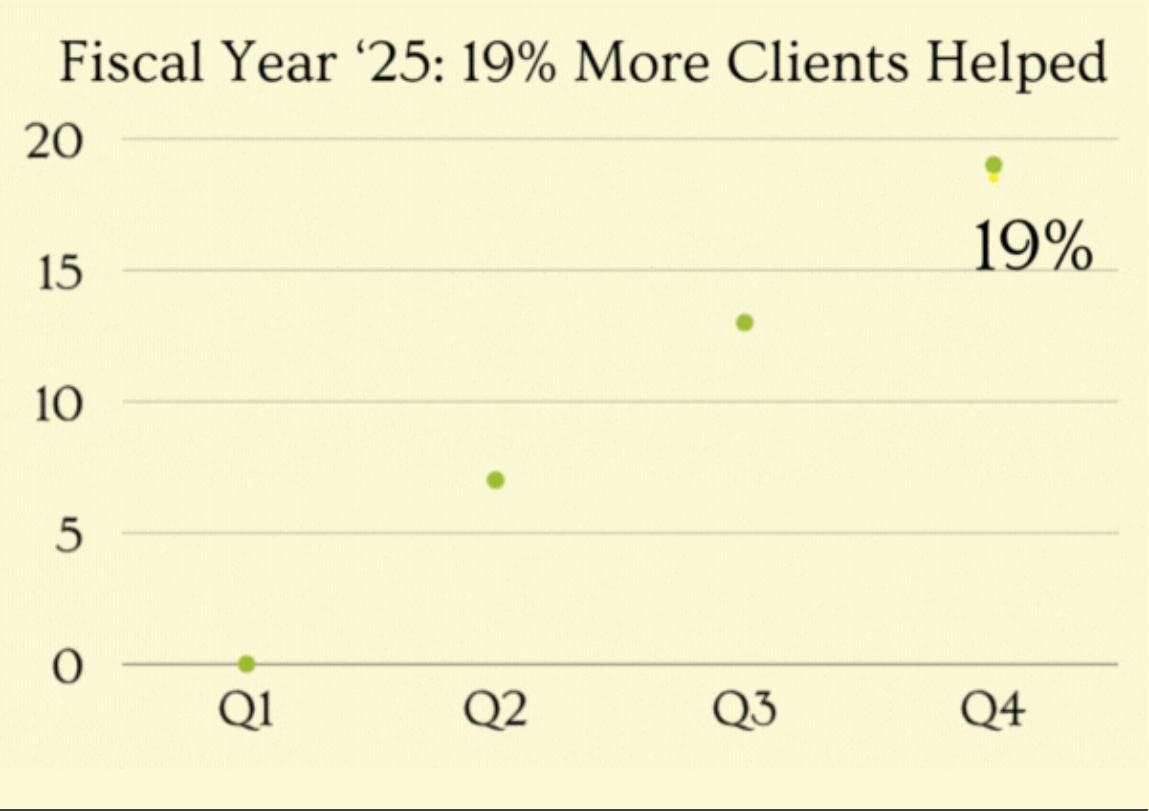

Our Impact: A Quick Look Back at Fiscal Year 2025

In September, we will publish our Gratitude Report, an in-depth view of the impact of our program, a recognition of our community partners and supporters, and a report of the organization's financial position.

In the meantime, we want to give you a quick look at our reach. In the last 12 months, CancerLINC provided legal advising, financial guidance, and community resource navigation to 19% more clients than in the prior year.

We know that cancer's ripple effects—mounting bills, insurance tangles, legal questions—keep growing. With your help, CancerLINC will continue to grow to meet those needs.



Did you know? More than 70 % of U.S. adults have no will on record. Without one, state laws decide how assets are distributed and who speaks for you in a medical crisis.

Drafting a will (along with powers of attorney and advance medical directives) is the

simplest way to:

- Ease stress on loved ones: clear instructions mean fewer legal hurdles and family disagreements.
- Safeguard children and dependents: you choose guardians and outline future care.
- Direct your legacy: support the people and causes that matter most.

If cancer has touched your life, these decisions feel even more urgent. CancerLINC offers estate-planning services such as wills, financial and healthcare powers of attorney, and advance medical directives, through our network of volunteer attorneys and financial planners. We serve patients and immediate family members throughout Greater Richmond, ensuring peace of mind at no cost to those who meet income guidelines.

What’s in the New “Big Bill” and Why It Matters to You

Legislation moves fast, and the latest federal “Big Bill” is packed with changes that could touch nearly every corner of daily life for individuals and families facing cancer. To help you cut through the noise, **Triage Cancer** has produced a lightning-round webinar that breaks down:

- Healthcare – When expanded insurance protections and cost caps take effect
- Finances & taxes – Updates on tax credits, student-loan relief, and consumer safeguards

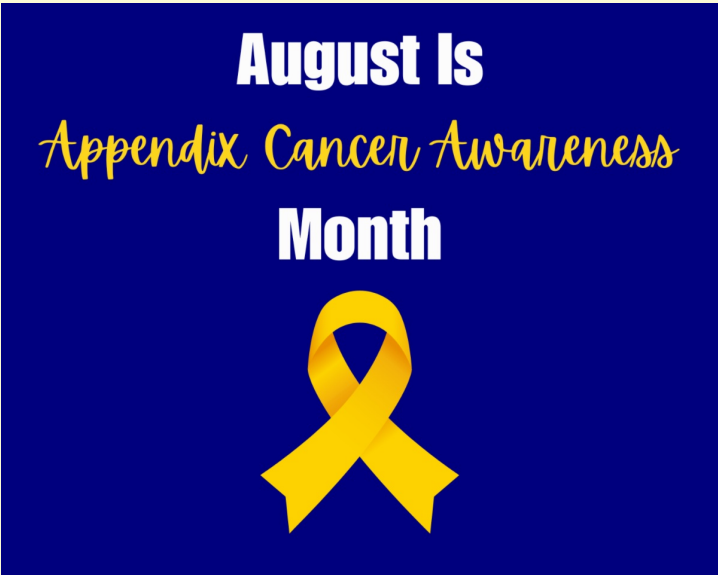
- Federal funding secured through June 2026 for core screening, registry and prevention programs, but warns of budget threats beyond that date.
