\$25 = 1 Hour of Lifeline Support

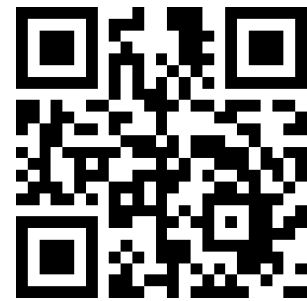
Provides housing help, food security, transportation assistance, insurance guidance, or utility support to one cancer patient.

Covers 2 hours of expert financial advising for a cancer patient navigating medical debt and daily living expenses.
